Mayor Fulmer called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

#### Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes:

Trustee Billmire moved to approve the minutes from the June 10, 2025, regular meeting, Trustee Ivanovic seconded; motion passed.

# Audience to Visitors

Simla resident, Kathy Wilkinson came before the Board to discuss what the plans are to develop the land to the west of Dollar General. Ms. Wilkinson stated that blowing sand & dirt is a problem at the library, school and baseball field. Ms. Wilkerson requested the Town to do something as it is an ongoing nuisance. Suggested an ordinance regarding erosion control. Mayor Fulmer stated he had reached out to the property owner but had not heard back yet. He does not think the property owner will have an issue with resolving the problem.

Simla resident, Bryce Lee came before the Board to discuss drainage issues around Crossroads. Mr. Lee presented pictures he took around Crossroads after the storm 2 weeks ago. He knows that the State is supposed to do something, but he cannot wait any longer. The two small drainage tubes that were installed a few years ago restrict the water from draining quickly enough in front of Crossroads. Mr. Lee stated he would like to be able to cut out those tubes and install some sort of bridge that can be removed to clean out the dirt that comes down from the top of the road. Mr. Lee would like to be able to dig out the ditch on the north side of Crossroads. Mayor Fulmer stated the Town needs to talk with the State. Mayor Fulmer stated it is hard to prepare for this type of flooding. Mr. Lee stated that this flooding is not a one-time event and happens at least once a year. Trustee Nehl stated the Stated does have a machine that cleans out ditches but it is booked out as there is only one for the entire State and the Town is on the list but there is no time frame of when they will be out. The Board approved Mr. Lee to dig out the ditch and the Town will contact the State regarding moving the drains from the concrete.

Bruce Coulson came before the Board to offer his business services of leveling headstones in the Cemetery. Mr. Coulson estimated there are 200 headstones that need to be leveled. He estimated he would charge \$100 per headstone, with the Town supplying the gravel and topsoil. Mr. Coulson stated that if he supplied the gravel, he estimated the cost to be \$150 per headstone. Mayor Fulmer asked Mr. Coulson to meet with Director McCune to triage headstones and possibly do the worst headstones.

Simla Property Owner of 811 & 813 Caribou Street, Rod Santos came before the Board to ask the Board to consider a variance to allow a resident living in a trailer at 813 Caribou to be allowed to move the trailer to 811 Caribou Street. Mr. Santos stated he has sold the 813 Caribou Street property. Trustee Nehl asked if there was a hook up at the 811 Caribou Street property. It was stated that there was one (1) on the north side of the property. Chief Kissam stated that the hooks up encroach on the neighboring property. Mr. Santos stated that that property owner had given permission for the trailer to encroach on her property. Chief Kissam stated the Town should get the neighboring property owners permission in writing. Mayor Fulmer stated that the trailer was grandfathered in at 813 Caribou Street, moving the trailer to 811 Caribou Street would need to be in compliance with current code requirements. Chief Kissam stated he is not surewhere the hook ups located on 811 Caribou Street run to. Mayor Fulmer stated that the trailer can be moved to 811 Caribou Street but cannot be hooked up. Code Enforcement Officer Stegmaier was not to issue a ticket for any code violations of moving the trailer to 811 Caribou Street until the issue was further addressed at the next Board meeting.

At this time Mayor Fulmer requested that new business item, a 2024 audit, be presented to the Board.

#### Attorney Report

Mr. Parikh stated that he has nothing more to add to his report that is not already on the agenda under unfinished and new business.

#### Clerks Report

A Company has been found that will come out to weed and feed the park. This was requested by Trustee Nipple. They will come out twice a year. Will be asking for a quote to have the park dethatched and aerated next year.

Full funding for water meter grant has been received

Quote provided in Board packet by Lally Property Services for \$4,950.00, to have dead tree limbs removed from trees in front of the HCC and a tree by the playground. This was requested by Trustee Nipple. A tree limb had fallen on a citizen's car in front of the HCC.

Trustee Billmire moved to approve the estimate provided by Lally Property Services, for dead limb removal, Trustee Nehl seconded; Mayor Fulmer called for discussion, none; motion passed unanimously.

An HVAC company was found to work on the heat pump system at the HCC. Several of the units are not working, making it very uncomfortable.

The Town received an email from Attorney Stan Kimble regarding the litigation the Town has on the Robin McCane property. He stated the Elbert County Sheriff would not set a date for the sale because the Decree of Foreclosure refers to both 207 Sioux Avenue and 211 Sioux Ave. The 211 Sioux Ave address needs to be removed before the sale can move forward. Mr. Kimble will file a motion with the court to amend the Towns decree.

#### Building Official/Code Enforcement - in packet

Building Official & Code Enforcement Office Stegmaier stated he had nothing to add to his report.

# Police Department - in packet

Chief Kissam stated they had put a bid on 2 police cars. Mayor Fulmer asked if he had it in his budget, Chief Kissam stated he had the funds in the Police Capital Reserve Fund.

#### Public Works - in packet

Director McCune stated he had nothing to add to his report.

The Board asked Director McCune about the status of spraying for mosquitoes. Director McCune stated the sprayer has been down, but he thinks they have it fixed.

# Mayor's Report

Mayor Fulmer stated that property owner Mark Mazerall called stating he needs a letter from the Town approving a car dismantling business to operate at the property he is selling at 600 Sioux Ave, Mr. Mazerall stated the buyer needs it for financing. After discussion the Board approved Mayor Fulmer to write a letter that the Town has no ordinances preventing that business from going in at 600 Sioux.

There has been some interest in the offices for rent at the Hope Community Center but not a lot.

Mayor Fulmer stated to provide accessibly access to citizen board meetings will have live captions on the TV in the meeting room so citizens can come to meetings and read the screen.

# UNFINISHED BUSINESS

# Waterline on Navajo- solution to prevent freezing

Trustee Kohring stated the County can get 4 culverts for \$2 400 for the driveways and then bring the street up, \$1250 of gravel. The County is willing to cover the cost of gravel and trucking. Trustee Billmire feels this will be a good fix to prevent freezing.

#### Speed Radar Camera - Resolution 397

Attorney Kunal stated the ordinance was drafted to meet State statutes and must be posted for 30 days with a 30-warning period. The contract was reviewed. Mayor Fulmer asked Mr. Kunal if the DACA agreement is worth it for the Town, Mr. Kunal stated it was. Trustee Ivanovic stated the Town will apply for 2 permits but will start with only 1 camera for east bound traffic, the second permit will be for future expansion for a west bound camera. Colorado statute forbids vendors billing per citation, and they must bill per camera per month. Speed study showed more violation leaving Town. Chief Kissam stated they want police presence in the school zone and where there is foot traffic. Chief Kissam stated the Town has a problem with speeding and this addresses the problem and is cheaper and safer than adding another

officer.

Trustee Ivanovic moved to approve resolution 397; Trustee Kohring seconded; Mayor Fulmer called for discussion, none; roll call taken, motion passed unanimously.

#### Presentation of 2024 Audit by Auditor Kyle Logan

Trustee van Zoeren moved to approve the 2024 audit; Trustee Billmire seconded; Mayor Fulmer called for discussion, none; motion passed unanimously.

#### Discussion of solutions for improving the Town's water quality

Clerk Taunton stated Trustee Nipple had done some research, and it would cost around \$100 per month per resident to fund a water treatment plant. Trustee vanZoeren stated that we didn't have water quality issues before the meters were installed. Director McCune states that when they flush hydrants in one part of Town they get complaints from another part of Town regarding the water. Trustee Ivanovic stated that there must be grants available to help address this issue.

Mayor Fulmer stated in 2019 the Town paid and Engineering firm \$20,000 for a report on how to fix the Towns water system. The Town spent \$1.9 million and water quality is still the same. Mayor Fulmer instructed Director McCune to contact the Towns current engineering firm to get a quote for a study on how to improve the water system, to present at the August meeting.

# Ordinance 347 – Amending section 6-4-3 regarding the subdivision application fee

Trustee Ivanovic moved to approve ordinance 347; Trustee vanZoeren seconded; Mayor Fulmer called for discussion, none; motion passed unanimously.

#### Sewer tap fee - Dollar General

Clerk Taunton stated that during the 2024 audit it was determined that the sewer tap fee for Dollar General was not collected. She was instructed by the Auditor to ask how the Board would like to proceed. The Board instructed Clerk Taunton to send a letter to the current owner regarding this matter.

306 Buffalo Street - Approval for Condemnation of Property

Chief Kissam stated the Town passed an ordinance regarding nuisance properties last year and this property falls under that ordinance. The property has ordinance violations regarding the property being a mess and the number of calls the Police Department to this address that turned out to be nothing, makes it a nuisance property. This property meets the criteria of the ordinance. Chief Kissam stated he just needs Board approval to present to the Judge, to work on prohibiting residency of the property or condemning the property or what the Judge sees fit. Mayor Fulmer stated this is exactly why the Town created this ordinance.

Trustee Billmire moved to approve the condemnation of 306 Buffalo Street; Trustee Nehl seconded; Mayor Fulmer called for discussion, Trustee vanZoeren asked if the land owner was notified, Chief Kissam stated he served the property owner personally the letter and he failed to comply with the letter, motion passed unanimously.

# Wastewater

- Wastewater samples submitted. We had elevated TSS and E-Coli. Took additional samples to lab and got back in compliance. No violation.
- Brad Harr had 3 RVs when we did re-reads and a 4<sup>th</sup> RV moved in on June 28<sup>th</sup>.
   Do we charge a full month for the one that moved in between reads and re-reads? Do we charge ½ month for the one that moved in on the 28<sup>th</sup> or only bill full months. That unit was hooked up to the sewer system for half a month.

# Water

Water samples submitted. Everything in compliance. Taking yearly, 3-year and 5-year samples in July, this will put us over the budget for sampling this year.
