

ORDINANCE NO. 365

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SIMLA COLORADO ADDING A NEW SECTION 6-1-8 TO THE TOWN CODE OF SIMLA CONCERNING THE WIDTH OF STREETS, AVENUES, AND ALLEYWAYS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to add a new section to the Town Code of Simla (the "Code") regarding requirements for the width of streets, avenues, and alleyways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Simla as follows:

Section 1. A new Section 6-1-8 is hereby added to the Town Code of Simla to be read as follows:

Section 6-1-8: WIDTH OF STREETS, AVENUES AND ALLEYWAYS:

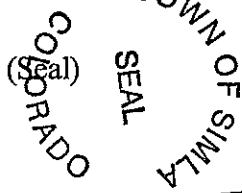
- A. Avenues which run north and south shall be eighty (80) feet wide. Streets which run east and west shall be sixty (60) feet wide. Alleyways shall be twenty (20) feet wide.
- B. Widths shall incorporate easements on both sides of streets and avenues to accommodate a concrete sidewalk or dirt walkway.
- C. All streets, avenues and alleyways shall be unobstructed pursuant to Section 3-1-3(D) of the Code.


Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that anyone, or part, or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3. Safety. The Board of Trustees finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication.
