

STANDING ORDER FOR CLERK AUTHORIZATION REGARDING IMPOSING DEFAULTS IN TRAFFIC SUMMONS RESULTING FROM THE AUTOMATED VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (PHOTO RADAR) PURSUANT TO TOWN OF SIMLA ORDINANCE NO. 350 (5-6-1-ET SEQ.)

The Town of Simla has by ordinance dated August 21, 2025 adopted the Colorado State Statute (42-4-110.5 C.R.S) regarding the use, and implementation of an automated vehicle identification system (photo radar) within the Town of Simla.

Pursuant to this Ordinance, in the event a Respondent fails to either pay, or request a hearing within the times specified by Ordinance; or, after having requested a hearing fails to appear at such hearing, a Default Judgment may be entered against the Respondent.

The Automated Vehicle Identification System known as "Photo Radar" is an electronic system (data base) maintained by a designated third- party vendor, and utilized by the Town Clerk of the Town of Simla to electronically log summons issued, monitor evidence submitted by the Respondent, monitor evidence maintained by the Town of Simla, monitor payments, monitor hearing requests, and monitoring defaults.

The Town of Simla has designated its Municipal Judge to act as a hearing officer (judicial officer) in overseeing this data base, and has designated the Municipal Judge to perform judicial functions, in addition to other legally significant events, regarding the entry of a default judgment against the Respondent for: failures to pay, request a hearing, or appear at a previously requested and scheduled hearing.

By this ORDER, the Municipal Judge does hereby grant authority to the Clerk of the Town of Simla, or her designee, to monitor the above- described data base regarding those respondents who have defaulted pursuant to the Ordinance, and to enter that legally significant fact into the above- described data base without further consultation with the Municipal Judge.
