1. Evaluate Town ordinances according to their pertinence to current practices and compliance with state and federal laws, as well as other local social and economic factors.
2. Confer with legal representation to ensure that potential ordinance changes comply with the law.
3. Recommend effective ordinance changes for prospective approval of the Town of Simla Board of Trustees by December 2019 at the latest.

Background: The Town ordinances, as a whole, have not been evaluated and updated for many years. Some of these local laws have either become irrelevant, or they do not match proceedings, operations, and enforcement in practice. In light of the desire to create fair and equitable local laws that benefit the Town of Simla and its citizens as a whole, Mayor Stegmaier has formed this committee at the request of the Board of the Trustees. All members of the public are invited to committee workshops, and their feedback is welcome.
